Characteristic of Effective Learning of the Month

In each newsletter we will focus on an area of the Characteristics of Effective Learning (CoEL). The CoEL are part of the Early Years Foundation Stage, they focus on HOW children learn alongside the areas of learning which focus on what children are learning.

Choosing ways to do things (Creating and Thinking Critically - THINKING)

This area of the CoEL may be observed in a child; Planning and making decisions about how to approach a task, solve a problem and reach a goal; Checking how well their activities are going; Changing strategy as needed and Reviewing how well the approach worked.

For children to be creative and critically think, we need to provide children with lots of opportunities to work things out on their own or with others; this will develop their problem solving skills. At times, adults will need to know when to intervene and scaffold their children's learning. As we know young children observe what is happening around them and they absorb the information. As children begin to engage fully in activities, they will start asking questions about how things work. At this stage, adults need to be skilful in asking open-ended questions to help extend the learning opportunities e.g 'What do you think might happen next?' or 'how are you going to do it?'

Please let us know if you will be joining us.

We have had a couple of cases of head lice at the Nursery and would ask you all to check your child's hair thoroughly. We need to ALL check our hair and treat if any headlice are found. For us to be successful in stopping the spread any further we ALL need to do this.

If any headlice are found the best way to treat them is to use conditioner and a nit comb and comb through your child's hair immediately. Please be aware that this will need to be done until all the eggs have hatched and it is not enough just to do it once, this could take up to a week.

We appreciate that this can be both costly and time consuming but is necessary to ensure we minimise future cases.

Funding Information 15 hours funding for 2 year olds.

You could be entitled to 2 year funding, 15 hours free a week. Check the eligibility criteria on the East Sussex County Council website - 2 year funding. If you are eligible for this then the hours can be accessed across 3 ams or 3 pms or a day and a half. Two year funding starts the term after their second birthday.

15 hours funding for 3 & 4 year olds.

Three and four year funding will remain universal as 15 hours and can be accessed across 3 ams or 3 pms or a day and a half. They are entitled to this funding the term after their third birthday and they can attend this term time only or part of additional sessions.

30 hours funding

If you are living and working in England, 3 and 4 year olds may be entitled to 30 hours childcare if you fit the eligibility criteria. They are entitled to this the term after their third birthday.

If you require further information or you would like help to apply for any of the above, then please ask your nursery manager.

Picnic in the Park

It would be a great opportunity for you to meet your child's friends and their families as well as get to know other parents of Artemis Nursery.

Toilet Training

We encourage children to explore their environment and engage in as many activities as they can during their time with us at nursery. So we ask that <u>all</u> children should have spare clothes on their peg in their Artemis bag at all times. If they have come home in their change of clothes, these will need to be replaced.

Please can we also have enough nappies and wipes for your child's time at nursery for all those children wearing nappies.
